

Dear Student,

I hereby inform you that, following the information from the Ministry of Innovation and Technology, on the basis of the Government Decree No. 40/2020. (III. 11.) on The State of Emergency, and in accordance with the decision of the Operational Team on 14 March 2020, the student dormitories of higher education institutions shall be emptied and students shall remove their personal belongings.

In order to implement the measure, the Hungarian citizen students shall leave their dormitory residence with all their belongings between 08:00 a.m. on 15 March 2020 and 2:00 p.m. on 17 March 2020.

The measures will have an effect on you since according to the decision, the remaining dormitory residents should be moved to as few buildings as possible during the week.

The leadership of the University is doing its best in order to find a solution that will cause you the least inconvenience. However, the execution of the measures ordered by the Maintainer is mandatory and shall be implemented by 20 March 2020 at the latest.

The measure shall be implemented by the Rector and the Chancellor of the University as follows:

Gödöllő Campus:

Gödöllő Dormitories Building A - All students shall stay in their current room, the remaining rooms will be assigned to residents from other buildings.

Gödöllő Dormitories Building B - This building will house all other residents who remain in the dormitory.

Budai Campus, Ybl Campus

All students in Somogyi Imre Dormitory will stay in the building, and the students of Ybl Miklós Faculty of Architecture will also be relocated here.

Tessedik Campus

2 PhD students currently residing at CERVUS Hostel C will be relocated to CERVUS Hostel A.

The new room assignments are ready, you will be informed about the details in the appropriate dormitory.

Since the most important thing in this situation is to protect the University community and prevent the epidemic from spreading, unfortunately we need to make provisions that cause difficulties in our daily routine.

Therefore, we ask for your kind patience and understanding in this situation.
